Marston students take 7 classes per day, while most schools offer just 6. Marston students get to choose an elective class from a list of about 10 choices. In addition to the elective class, Marston students take 10 exploration courses throughout the year during first period. Marston offers about 50 of these 3-week, nongraded, exploration courses and students only attend the exploration classes that they personally selected. We believe that it is only when students engage in something they are truly passionate about, that they can realize their full potential. Our structure allows students to build on their strengths and also explore potential new passions.

At Marston, we believe in all of our students and pride ourselves on integrating college-prep rigor into all courses. This is only possible because of the excellent teachers we have. Marston teachers are very experienced, compassionate and invested in the school and community. Marston has a very stable faculty; many Marston teachers have been working here for more than 15 years.

#### **Comprehensive Student Support**

We continuously have a pulse on each student's academic progress. Every 3 weeks, each student takes a test on the key learning targets from each core class. Students who do not pass the assessment participate in an intervention class where the student learns the content in a different format. This second attempt at learning helps students learn the key content and become prepared for the upcoming content. In addition to intervention classes offered during advisory, teachers make themselves available for extra help a few times per week. The Marston library is also open for help and enrichment before school, during lunch and after school. Reaching every child is possible at Marston because of the commitment, compassion and determination of all of our staff members.

#### **Academic Distinctions**

Marston's test scores have increased annually since the implementation of the SBAC test.

Marston exceeds the State average in all 6 testing categories. Marston regularly wins awards at local competitions such as The iVies (video production), CCTE Showcase (Project-Based Learning) and SoCal FLL Robotics.

#### **Advanced Classes**

Marston's standard courses put students on the pathway to college acceptance. Marston also offers *Accelerated Math* and *Advanced English* for students performing above grade level.

Neighborhood enrollment has significantly increased over the past 10 years. About 80% of Marston students are from one of Marston's five feeder elementary schools (Alcott, Bay Park, Cadman, Holmes and Toler).
